



Terms and Conditions

General

- By signing up to the 500 Club you agree to be bound by these terms and conditions
- Monies raised by the 500 Club will support the general work of Jewish Care Scotland, registered charity number SCO 05267
- Entrants must be 16 years of age or over; no number can be sold to, on behalf of, or for a person under the age of 16. If a number is sold unknowingly to, on behalf of, or for a person under the age of 16 they will be exempt from the draw and will forfeit their prize and the money will be returned
- You will provide accurate entry information, including your name and personal address
- Entry is open to all residents of the UK (including JCS staff and volunteers) but excludes: Chief Executive, Fundraising Manager and Fundraising & Communications Officer
- Jewish Care Scotland may decline an application or cancel an existing subscription without giving any reason or notice at its discretion
- Jewish Care Scotland may terminate or suspend the lottery without giving any reason or notice at its discretion
- In the event of an error, howsoever caused, whether a printing error or otherwise, which affects the competition in any way, the organiser reserve the right to administer the raffle as though the error had not occurred
- Failure to comply with any of these rules may result in the disqualification of the entry. Jewish Care Scotland reserves the right to disqualify any entry at their absolute discretion
- There is one monthly prize, which is 20% of the monthly income from the lottery

Example of monthly prize

Monthly prize (20%)	£100	£250	£500

Membership

- Members of the 500 Club are required to sign up for a minimum of 12 months
- There can be no more than 500 members of the 500 Club
- All members will receive a certificate to confirm their allotted numbers

Payment

- Entry costs £5 per number, payable in advance by standing order, cash or cheque
- Your number will be entered into the draw only when the whole payment is received
- To be entered into the monthly draw payment must be received by 5pm on the last Thursday of every month
- Jewish Care Scotland is not liable for any entry money that reaches us after 5pm on the last Thursday of every month
- If you send a cheque or money in the post, proof of posting is not proof of delivery

The draw

- The winning number will be drawn with a random number generator
- The result of the draw is final. No correspondence will be entered into
- The draw will take place on the last Friday of every month, or if this is not possible, on the next working day

Winners

- Winners will be notified in writing as soon as possible after the draw and will be sent their cheques within 14 days of the draw
