Jewish Care Scotland – The Heart of the Community

It has been another successful year for JCS, and this is largely thanks to the continuing partnership between our staff, donors and volunteers.

The need for our services is as great now as it has ever been in the 159 years since the first beginnings of a Jewish welfare organisation in Scotland. Faced with an ageing population, we can only anticipate that the need will continue to increase.

We are striving to ensure we provide quality services to all our clients while planning to meet their future needs and aspirations. Generally, we are benefitting from living longer lives and at JCS we are listening to our clients and are working hard to shape our services in a way which will meet individual needs and, in particular, will enable people to continue to live independently for as long as they wish.

The Walton Community Care Centre in May Terrace is a hub for all kinds of activity. The importance of being able to provide a safe and comfortable place to meet friends, enjoy good food and take part in stimulating activities cannot be under-estimated. For clients and carers alike, the clubs at JCS provide a real lifeline.

Alongside our six days a week services for older people, we are privileged to be able to come alongside others in the communities to support them through difficult times in their lives. In 2016 this has included supporting Jewish asylum seekers to settle in Scotland, with all the help with immigration, housing, education and employment that this entails. Also, on a weekly basis, our dedicated Social Care staff assist people with addictions, mental health difficulties, concerns with debt, and a myriad of other challenges.





The Walton Community Care Centre is home to our Day Centre, which plays a significant and vibrant role at Jewish Care Scotland. We run four clubs, five days of the week with plans to increase this to six days, Sunday to Friday.

Aviv Day Care

Our flagship Care Inspectorate registered day care service is a unique partnership between JCS and East Renfrewshire Council. The Club runs on a Monday and Wednesday for senior adults who require some support and are looking for social interaction. Many become involved in their hobbies, chair yoga, arts & crafts, entertainers, singing or quizzes as well as a beautician and an on-site hairdresser. These activities are spread throughout the week and attendance can help, as part of a support package, to assist people to remain living independently for as long as possible. Staff assist people with maintaining independence and also provide transport for those requiring it.



Thistle Club

This is a popular social lunch club for many active senior adults on Tuesdays and Thursdays. The attendance varies and we have a volunteer-assisted Culture Club and a self-driven Discussion group. Along with arts & crafts, invited speakers and entertainers, the Chanukah party, summer outings and Burns lunch are enjoyed alongside traditional Jewish festivals. Staff from the day centre are on hand to offer support and to provide transport for those requiring it.



Kandu

This is a separate partnership between JCS and East Renfrewshire Council for adults with enduring physical illnesses. The group offers an opportunity for adults to socialise and enjoy engaging discussions, lunch and snacks. The beautician attends on a monthly basis and all club members are able to join in with the Thistle club activities if they wish, giving them an opportunity for a wider social interaction. Occasional external activities are organised and staff from the day centre support each person and transport all from this club to and from home.

Sunday Club

The popular Sunday club is a weekly social group for senior adults and is run in partnership with the Jewish Blind Society. This is a casual high tea in the early afternoon and is supported by staff from the Day Centre, who also provide transport for those who require it.

Our yearly Chanukah party is always a great success and 2016 was no different with the room beautifully decorated with adornments and dreidel bunting made by our Arts and Crafts volunteers and club members. Traditional Chanukah food, including potato latkes and doughnuts, was catered by Kosher Kitchens, followed by entertainment provided by Music in Hospitals.

Thanks to the generous support of the community, guests received a gift wrapped fruit basket made by a team of JCS volunteers. One of the guests, a Culture Club member, said:

"It was wonderful. It couldn't have been nicer; everyone worked so hard and made it look beautiful. We even got a gift to take home which was lovely."


First Class Transport

In the past year Jewish Care Scotland has purchased two new minibuses and a wheelchair accessible car to replace the old minibuses. This would not have been possible without the support of the Jewish Community, with particular thanks to The Walton Foundation.

Transport is essential for our daily clubs. People who would otherwise have no means of getting to JCS are able to attend our Day Centre. The purchase of these vehicles shows that Jewish Care Scotland will be here for the future; we will continue providing for the Jewish Community and meeting their needs.

The addition of the wheelchair accessible car has also meant greater ease for working on a one to one basis with clients. The Fundraising Team has also found it particularly helpful; it's a great size for transporting all their equipment around for fundraising events!

JCS are incredibly grateful to all the donors who contributed to the minibus fund.



A Rewarding Friendship



Volunteering has numerous benefits; one in particular is the chance to make friends. Back in April 2000 Claire Miller and Freda Kostick both saw an advert in the Jewish Telegraph, inviting people interested in volunteering to come along to Jewish Care Scotland. On the day the place was packed and they both sat down at the same table and got chatting. It turned out that they both lived on the same street. Freda didn't drive so Claire said to her: "If you volunteer on the same day as me you will never be without a lift."

They've now been volunteering for 17 years and Claire still picks Freda up every Wednesday morning. They've been with Jewish Care Scotland through lots of changes, they've seen staff, clients and volunteers come and go. Freda says: "Jewish Care Scotland is a lovely environment; there isn't any other place like this. We get a lot of satisfaction. The club members are full of interesting stories and laughter. It's a happy place."


Claire says: "I'm getting on now, but I'm still good for a blether!"
